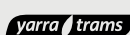

RAIL CAREERS IMMERSION DAY

Located in the real-life rail environment at the Rail Academy in Newport.

A hands-on immersive experience day designed to showcase the variety of careers available in rail and rail infrastructure to students in years 7 to 10. Students will actively participate in activities such as track building, safeworking on rail, track measurement, station platform management, a manual signalling demonstration and more!

SAFETY IN RAIL WORKSHOP

Students will undertake a realistic branching pathways scenario to see the consequences of decision making on personal safety.

Rail is a safety-critical environment that requires workers to role model exceptional safety behaviours to protect the public and other rail workers.

SUSTAINABILITY AND URBAN PLANNING AND DESIGN WORKSHOP

Students will hear from people working in the booming fields of Sustainability and Urban Planning and Design, learning what educational and career pathways are available.

They'll also undertake a detailed demographic analysis activity to work through how to make a new station build sustainable, functional and liveable for a chosen community.

STEM WORKSHOP

Empowering students to consider a career in transport and infrastructure

Rail Academy's STEM workshop is an opportunity for Year 7 to 10 students to engage with some of Victoria's industry leaders.

Students will undertake a realistic design activity for a train station, where they will make planning, budgeting and environmentally-minded decisions that simulate real project operations in transport infrastructure.
